Sliding Fee Scale

Some providers and programs indicate that their fees are on a sliding scale. This means that fees for the program are based on income standards set by the program.

Fees Negotiable

Your child care program may be willing to negotiate fees on an individual basis.

Multi-Child Discounts

Your child care program may offer a fee reduction to parents with more than one child enrolled in care.

Parents are encouraged to inquire about these services at their current child care program, or call our Family Connections Specialist for referrals to programs that offer these supports at (877) 425-0009.

Other Opportunities for Financial Assistance
