PARENTS RECEIVE

- Assistance in locating before and after-school care, emergency back-up, mildly ill child care services, vacation and holiday care.
- Information to help parents determine the type of program that best serves the needs of both child and family. Options include child care centers, family child care programs, nursery schools, Head Start and Universal Pre Kindergarten.
- Help in accessing services for children with special needs, including integrated care arrangements, child care subsidies, and support services.
- Comprehensive support that empowers parents to make informed choices for their children.
- Stable supply of child care providers through ongoing recruitment and training of caregivers.

Child Care Resources of Rockland, Inc. is a contract agency of the County of Rockland, the Rockland County Youth Bureau, The NYS Office of Children and Family Services, The United Way of Rockland County, NYS Department of Health and the Rockland County School Districts. Additional funding for Special Needs Services is provided by Family Support Services, Mental Health Services and Office of People with Developmental Disabilities. Child Care Resources of Rockland is supported by Rockland Community College
